## Notes from Dr. Lee



It is estimated about 650,000 people are homeless in the US and about 250,000 are unsheltered on any night. Scores in Kansas City may be found in the corners of underpasses and in encampments in parks and by the rivers and creeks where they sleep “rough”, camping out in all weather. Their medical problems are complicated by their lack of shelter and lack of other resources.

Reginald is homeless. Last winter he was hit by a car while walking along a busy street and sustained a severe fracture of his wrist which required hospitalization and surgery with internal placement of pins and plates. Shortly after the surgery, Reggie was discharged from the hospital. Adequate wound care was not possible, he could not buy the prescribed antibiotics or dressing materials and soon an infection set in, nine months later his radius (main forearm bone to the thumb) was nearly eroded through with severe infection when FHC’s Nurse Practitioner, KayKay, found him in an encampment with pus draining from his nearly useless arm.

Initially it was thought he would require an amputation mid-forearm. But the referral surgeons found another way. After another series of surgeries, it was time again for discharge from the hospital. But to where? Reggie needed daily IV antibiotics and dressing changes and still was sleeping out. For four weeks, FHC staff and volunteers picked him up daily and brought him to FHC for wound care and IV treatments. FHC staff provided health care, treated his depression, brought in donated warm clothes, a bicycle and even helped him replace his personal identification, which had been stolen. This winter, Reggie has accepted placement in a shelter and he has a functioning hand. The “Care Beyond the Boulevard” crew from FHC are busy helping others. Thanks to each of you for support of FHC’s mission to make our world better.

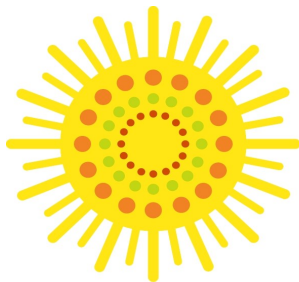
